



# Christmas Camp at Covenant Point

## December 27, 2009—January 1, 2010

### Housing Options –

**Maple Lodge:** 8 rooms housing 3–4 people per room, three bathrooms for the lodge and a lounge area shared by all rooms.

**Aspen and Birch Lodges:** 2 rooms housing 12 people per room, each room having a private bathroom and a small lounge shared by both rooms (minimum fee of one room is full time rate for 4 adults).

**Pine Lodge:** 4 rooms housing 10–12 people per room, two bathrooms for the lodge and a large lounge shared by all rooms.

**Cedar Lodge:** 4 rooms housing 10 people per room, each room has a private bathroom and a large lounge shared by all rooms (minimum fee of one room is the full time rate of 4 adults). The lounge area overlooks the indoor climbing wall which will be used by people throughout the week on a limited schedule.

**Squirrel Cage:** 3 bedroom housekeeping unit; one room with two bunk beds, one room with a double bed and a bunk bed and one room with a queen size bed (minimum fee is the full time rate of 5 adults).

### Camp Policies:

**Our first meal together is on December 27<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm** plan on staying after the meal for our first meeting together. The last planned activity each day will be an intergenerational devotional time.

Every day after breakfast, the staff will clean the lodge bathrooms and vacuum the lounge area. If a problem arises, please talk to Kyle or Colby.

Candy and soda machines can be found in the game room. Please keep food in the cabins in tightly sealed containers.

Help us save on energy. We try to keep the thermostats at 65 degrees. Bring a sweater and stoke up the wood stove to be cozy.

All wet, snowy boots should be left at the entrance of your lodge and in the vestibule of the Dining Hall.

### Directions to Covenant Point Bible Camp –

From Chicago area take Interstate 43 north from Milwaukee, then take Hwy. 41 north to Iron Mountain. Turn west (left) on US Hwy 2 and travel to Iron River. About 1 mile past town, turn south on M73 to Hagerman Lake Rd. Turn right on Hagerman Lake Rd. and travel for 1 and 1/2 miles to camp.

From Rockford area take Interstate 90/94 north to Hwy 51. Travel north to Hwy 8 and go east on Hwy 8 into Rhinelander and then follow the signs to Hwy 17 north. Take Hwy 17 north to Eagle River to Hwy 55. Turn north (left) on Hwy 55. In Michigan Hwy 55 becomes M 73. Take M 73 north to Hagerman Lake Rd. Turn left on Hagerman Lake Rd. and travel 1 and 1/2 miles to camp.
