The Central Conference of the Evangelical Covenant Church, in partnership with Covenant Point Bible Camp and a team of Central Conference youth pastors, want to invite you to consider Adventures in Leadership (AIL) for your students. AIL is a small-group, wilderness, discipleship and leadership training experience designed for young people who are entering grades 10-12.

Inspired by a similar model successfully used in the Northwest Conference for many years, the Central Conference now has six years of our own successful AIL programs under our belt, and about 89 students who have successfully completed our program. This summer, (June 23-29, 2019) we are excited to continue this unique leadership program at Covenant Point Bible Camp and on-trail along Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore on Lake Superior.

You and your church are invited to select one or two students, who will be entering grades 10-12, for application to AIL. This program has very limited space available, as we only accept 16 students each summer. Applications must be completed by Friday, March 15, 2019.
