Dear High School Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in a work crew position at Covenant Point Bible Camp for the summer of 2013. Our camp witnesses to the reality of God's love and salvation through Jesus Christ. Our volunteer work crews help out with grounds and kitchen work, and interact with campers. If you have a heart for ministry, are hard-working, and have a mature attitude, you may be selected to be a part of the work crew this summer.

Work crew is essentially a volunteer mission with food and housing provided. Please be sure to check your schedules, because work crew members should be at camp for the entire session they select. You may apply for any and all sessions if you wish. Acceptance will be on a space-available basis. If you wish to apply, to any or all sessions, proceed as follows:

- 1. Return your finished application
- 2. Have two personal references sent directly to camp from your pastor, a teacher or other non-relative or non-peer.
- 3. Be prepared for an in-person or telephone interview sometime this spring

The sessions available are:

Session 1	June 9 - July 6	Kitchen or Grounds	4 week session
Session 2	July 6 – Aug 10	Kitchen or Grounds	5 week session

We prefer applicants to be 16 years old or older. Occasionally we will hire crew younger than 16. We look forward to receiving your application. We will begin making assignments January 1, 2012. No application will be considered until it is complete, including references.

- 2. Why do you want to work at Covenant Point this summer?
- 3. What do you think being a servant means in a camp setting?
- 4. List any work experience or skills that would be useful to camp.

Our expectations of Applicant:

Christian leadership is the key to our camping ministry. The commitment, attitude, example, and verbal witness of camp staff contribute more than any other factors to a camper's openness and responsiveness to the Gospel. It is essential that all applicants be willing to:

- 1. Share their life in Christ by example and word with campers and other staff.
- 2. Be flexible and go beyond their job description. At various times throughout the summer, you may be called on to do anything from building program props to cleaning toilets.
- 3. Participate in camp activities as requested.
- 4. Adhere to community guidelines such as curfew times and participation in daily program events.

The Central Conference Camp Board prohibits the use of tobacco products and/or the drinking of alcoholic beverages by Covenant Point and Covenant Harbor staff members on the camp grounds or at any camping ministry event. The use of drugs shall be limited to such as prescribed by a physician. The abuse of any substance, (legal or illegal) or habit, or inappropriate sexual behavior may be cause for dismissal. Work crew members are not permitted to have motor vehicles at camp. Appropriate dress, such as hair nets or headbands for kitchen staff, hard soled shoes for outdoor work, noise canceling head phones, and other special items may be required. Modest swim wear is required.
