Mainland: Grades 2-12

Covenant Point's Mainland offers a classic residential camp experience with a wide range of program options for all ages. Campers enjoy all sorts of activities from swimming, sailing and tubing on our waterfront to team-building and big games on the big field, to arts and crafts and campfires, to archery and ropes courses for older campers. Staff-led devotions foster faith conversations, create an environment of fun and encourage holistic growth.

Island: Grades 6-8

One mile offshore from our Mainland, Covenant Point's 8.5 acre Island offers a small community wilderness experience unlike any other! Campers live in a yurt, worship daily around a campfire, enjoy meals in the open-air shelter and become immersed in the natural environment with a closeknit group of 32 campers and 6 staff. Our Island offers several high ropes courses, ropes swings, a zipline, kayaks, team games, a NEW sauna and more.

Trips: Grades 6-12, & Adults

Covenant Point wilderness trips are back! With the lakes and woods of the U.P. and Northern Wisconsin at our doorstep, campers have quick access by backpack or canoe to beautiful backcountry locations, guided by our trained staff. Deep friendships form while paddling, hiking, taking in the beautiful sights and reflecting together around the evening campfire. Our trips program offers challenge, fun and adventure for middle and high school age campers, as well as adults.
